Paine Art Center and Gardens Educational Program Policies

All Student Groups:

- All programming done in collaboration with Education Staff is free of charge.
- At least a **two week notice** is required for any programming requests.
- One adult chaperone per eight students is required. Chaperones are free of charge. Paine staff members, volunteers, and docents cannot act as chaperones.
- Student capacity is determined by programing type.

Homeschool Groups:

- 15 student minimum is required to be considered an educational group/program.
- Programming may be limited to a specific age range.
- One adult per household is considered a chaperone, additional adults will need to pay admission.

Scout Groups, Youth Groups, Etc.:

• To receive free programming an educational goal needs to be met (i.e. earning a badge).

The Paine withholds the right to cancel any group tours that do not abide by the above policies upon arrival, and will not provide refunds in such cases.
